As such there is close interaction with other NSG functions: Manufacturing Excellence, Engineering, Procurement and the Sustainability Group, as well as the flat glass plants themselves. Technical support requests are often unplanned and urgent, requiring a rapid, effective response, sometimes with travel required at short notice.

- Science or Engineering degree qualified with minimum 5 years relevant work experience.
- Excellent organisational, IT, and presentation skills.

- Project management experience would be advantageous.
- A willingness to travel within the UK and overseas, sometimes at short notice, for periods of a few days to a few weeks is essential.
